

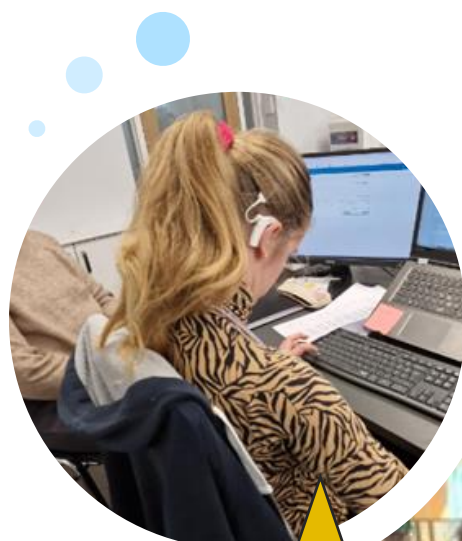
What a great year with Bridges into Work!
